



## A Description of League Boundaries for the FNWLL Playing Area

As a basis for determining whether you are part of the “Formal” FNWLL playing area, you must live in Midland County and your residence must be north of the Tittabawassee River. If you meet the County and River requirements and meet the following boundaries, your residence is considered part of the FNWLL league:

- 1) West of Jefferson Avenue or south of Ashman St.
- 2) West of Washington avenue and south of Sugnet.
- 3) North of Highway 10 and East of Waldo while also within Midland County.

As you move towards the west towards Sanford, there is a boundary just before reaching the City of Sanford proper. If your residence is located out towards Sanford and outside of the Midland City Limits, Please see a board representative to determine which league you may belong.

If you live outside of the area listed above, you are still welcomed to play baseball as part of FNWLL for the regular season but will be limited in some of the post season benefits offered to most players once the season is complete. However, most of these opportunities will come after a player reaches 8 years of age. For all players, the league just wants you to have the best experience possible no matter where you play.
